

CSC Meeting Minutes

Monday, September 12 4 p.m.

Discussion:

1. Community Member – CSC received an email from an interested community member, Robyn Wille. CSC discussed her statement of interest and decided to ask her to join the CSC. Marisa will reach out to her.
2. CSC Training – Ms. Sterrett reviewed the purpose of the CSC with the members.
 - a. The CSC is a collaborative process.
 - b. The CSC is an advisory group who makes decisions and recommendations by consensus.
 - c. The CSC advises on the UIP and budget as well as other ways to enhance student achievement and support the school climate.
 - d. Ms. Sterrett shared a handout comparing the SLT and the CSC. Ms. Sterrett also shared a survey regarding the way in which the principal interacts with the CSC.
3. Test Results
 - a. Ms. Sterrett shared with the CSC the school test results.
 - b. Ms. Sterrett intends to look at the school's math curriculum and talk with other GT/HGT schools to explore the options that are available to ensure the school is best meeting the needs of its students.
 - c. The State of Colorado changed the requirements for certain state tests and social studies and science will only be given once every 3 years for each school. This year, Polaris will be administering social studies for 4th grade.
4. UIP
 - a. The UIP is typically begun in the fall.
 - b. Ms. Sterrett anticipates having a literacy goal related to genre studies; a whole child goal; and possibly a math goal.
