Dear Families,

The following is a quick introduction to The Auction, and how you can help! Your help is essential for success. **We are seeking donations and buy-a-shares with a March 23, 2018 deadline.**

Attached are donation forms. These FORMS can also be found on the school website and in the office.

### **What is the Auction?**

An adult evening of fun and fundraising on April 7th with food, drinks, music and of course— silent and live auctions. Mingle with the Polaris community, have fun and raise funds for Polaris!

### **Donations that typically sell well at The Auction:**

- Staycations (Arvada, Golden, Boulder)
- Neighborhood packages (restaurants, businesses)
- Kid Fun/ Education (camps, museums, attractions, classes)
- Adult Night Out (theater, concerts, film)
- Ski/Mountains (lift tickets, equipment, condo/house for a weekend)
- Alcohol (wine, spirits)
- Fitness (gym memberships, yoga classes, personal training)
- Sports (Rockies, Broncos, Avalanche, round of golf)
- Spa-Beauty (pedicure, facial, massage)
- Jewelry-Accessories
- Professional Services

### **What are buy-a-shares?**

A buy-a-share is typically a parent-hosted event with a certain amount of openings for sale. A specific fee for each attendee is charged. This is for either a group of kids or a group of adults. Each "buy" into the event (typically 25 or 50 dollars) goes to the school.

**This year, ALL BUY-A-SHARE (BAS) experiences will be offered at The Auction. Again, this will be the ONLY Polaris event to offer BASs - for both adults and kids.** (See more information below\*\*)

### **BUY A SHARE INFO\*\***

Grab a friend or two, get creative, and host a fun event! You pick the theme, a summer date, and plan away. Buy-A-Share events foster the community feel that is necessary to make Polaris thrive. Your event doesn't have to be expensive; simple BASs such as a kids' movie/pizza party or an adult wine/beer tasting are easy to organize, fun, and hot items to bid on. All BAS events need to occur between May 1st and August 31st, 2018.

The cost-per-share is usually between \$25-50 (depending on if it's a kid vs. adult event, couples vs. single, large group vs. small group, etc.) and PTO will invoice parents directly. You provide the food and/or activity, and for kid events, you will supervise so parents can drop kids off.
