Discussion:

1. **Membership update:**
 - a. May timing for ePost for new member.
 - b. Robyn will continue as community member.
 - c. Teachers will elect another member because Jessica is at the end of her 2 year term.
2. **UIP update:** Executive summary of the UIP.
 - a. Professional support and update
 - b. Assessing literacy using STAR as primary measure. ANet for interims – teachers created their own in addition to ANets for both math and literacy
 - c. Math – even more systematic for how we are going to use HGT math test using it for teaching math and accelerating a grade level; we have kids who learn very quickly in different ways; teachers always looking for ways to compact and accelerate; other classes are compacted and accelerated.
 - Math HGT test – scoring it on May 15; it was administered last year too
 - given to all grades;
 - 5th grade takes the 6th grade placement test administered by the district
 - for incoming 3rd graders – come on the May 8th or the 10th – to experience the school; it will be orientation for the new kids; go to lunch and specials
 - d. Love and Logic – being taught to teachers and paras; helpful tips and tools for parents based on Love and Logic on the website under parent resources.

4. **Committee update –**
 - a. SLT is school leadership team; meet once/month. Established online Google calendar for staff. Anna (secretary) puts the information on the calendar.
 - SLT is elected by staff
 - Student discipline – this is why we did Love and Logic. Talk about what is not working in SLT. Lisa (psychologist) will be here full time. She will also teach classes in every class on social and emotional development. She’s also going to go to data meetings with teacher

teams so she can offer support for new ideas on handling discipline issues.

- b. **Math committee** – to discuss grade level acceleration; teachers are bringing in more resources than math in focus. All the teachers that teach math.

- f. PTO – focus on fundraising and events; Annual Fund giving has dropped off – trying to figure out what will work for this population of people; focus on events.
