Coach Kelsey trains regularly with Lior to master the PALS curriculum



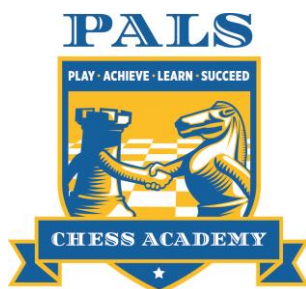
We will focus on developing critical-thinking skills through chess
