6. CSC update

- a. Jody Hyde and Mary Parker, Co-Chairs. Spoke to updates from CSC meeting, mainly electing new officers and training for transitioning back to school. Also spoke to considering implementing DEI, Know Justice, Know Peace curriculum.

7. Treasurer's Report- Kelly S.

a. Budget

- i. Approved 2020 Budget anticipated net loss of \$700
  - 1. Actual FY2020 ended with net loss of \$5,637
- ii. Approved 2020 income of \$127,900
  - 1. Actual income of \$107,512 (difference - raised less about 20k)
- iii. Approved 2020 Expenses \$128,600
  - 1. Actual expenses of \$113,149 (difference - spent about \$15k less)
- iv. Yearbook check (normally would've hit in FY2020) has not yet come in
- v. Year to date Update
  - 1. September we are fairly close to last year.
  - 2. October and November had significantly funds raised last year, so fundraising efforts need to come close to matching this year.
- vi. Tax form due 11/15. Kelly working on finishing with the auction.
- vii. Grants? Nothing precludes us, we just have to consider requirements involved if we qualify and if we can adhere.
